Pact consists of chairs at various heights, tables to be used separately or in conjunction with the seating and privacy screens, sometimes free standing and sometimes embodied in the chair. Setle is available as a handsome new lounge chair or side chair with a very sculpted appearance. We were happy to actually experience the new products but disappointed to miss seeing our old friend Mike Keilhauer.
